| <b>SURF Awards</b><br>Summer Undergraduate Research Fund   | Funds summer research or creative projects supervised by UConn faculty.   | Graduate no earlier than December 2026   | Up to \$5,000 in stipend and \$500 in supplies |
| <b>BOLD Women's Leadership Network</b>   | Focuses on facilitating opportunities for women's leadership on campus through scholarship funding, programming, and engagement in service/leadership projects.   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 2<sup>nd</sup> year students</li> <li>• Extended commitment of academic year programming and summer project over 2026-2028</li> </ul> | Scholarship and summer project support         |
| <b>Change Grants</b><br>UConn Co-op Legacy Fellowship Program  | Supports student-designed or student-led projects related to social impact, public engagement, and social innovation.   | FALL DEADLINES: Graduate no earlier than May 2026<br>SPRING DEADLINES: Graduate no earlier than December 2026  | Up to \$4,000                                  |

| <b>SHARE Virtual Summer Apprenticeship Program</b><br>Social Sciences, Humanities, and Arts Research Experience | Introduces students to social science, humanities, or arts research via a virtual apprenticeship with faculty.                     | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1st–3rd year students</li> <li>• Major in social sciences, humanities, or arts;</li> <li>• Eligible for on-campus employment</li> </ul> | Up to \$1,485 earned as hourly wage   |
| <b>Work-Study Research Assistant Program</b>  | Students with Federal Work-Study as part of their financial aid packages may earn their awards by assisting with faculty research. | Students with Federal Work-Study (FWS) are eligible to apply for Research Assistant positions in 12Twenty.   | FWS awards are made by the Office of Student Financial Aid Services based on students' FAFSA information. |
